## **Affidavit for Partial Payment of Property Taxes**

Chapter 197.374 Florida Statute allows a taxpayer to make partial payments of the current year taxes. A partial payment cannot be applied to future year payments, delinquent taxes, tax deferrals or any account involved in litigation, including those in which petitions have been filed with the Value Adjustment Board. If there is an escrow account set up (property taxes are paid as part of the mortgage payment), partial payments will not be accepted on that account. In addition, partial payments will not be accepted on accounts that are on the quarterly installment payment plan for the current year.

By entering into this agreement with the Tax Collector, the taxpayer agrees to pay an additional \$10 processing fee per partial payment, forfeit any discounts, and make final payment of all taxes by March 31 to avoid a tax certificate being sold on the property.
